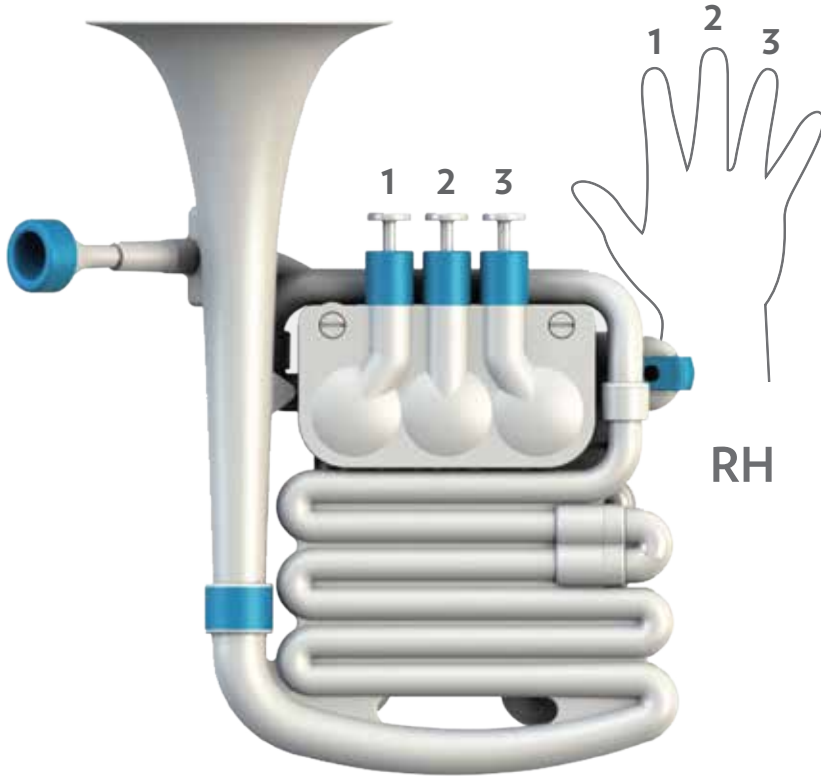




jHorn Fingering Chart - Treble Clef



Your jHorn must be set up in concert pitch, or the key of C, to use this fingering chart. Refer to the leaflet that came with the instrument to ensure you have the correct tubing on your jHorn.



The fingering is the same as a standard trumpet but your jHorn will sound one octave lower than the notes shown.

The thumb rests comfortably against the silicone on the first valve.

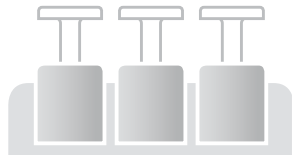
